PROJECT SCOPE

- Five identified heads of female headed families were producing Palmyra hand crafts as their income generating activity.
- They were producing ecofriendly Palmyra, winnowing fans, steamers, mats, palm hats and different kinds of bags. Products are being supplied to the local market and Palmyra Development Board (Katpagam).
- This livelihood development project provided coloring material to the identified beneficiaries to increase their production capacity to cater the demand in the market, while improving their livelihoods.
- Apart from providing coloring materials, the project provided automatic broom stick finishing machine from the Industrial Development Board to three internally displaced families who are engaged in small business of making ekel brooms in order to improve their business.
- All the above heads were given an awareness on sound financial management, packaging of products and marketing for long term sustainability of their income generating activities.

PROJECT OUTCOME

- Improved the livelihoods of five heads of women headed families in Mannar District by providing equipment and coloring materials to produce more and quality products.
- Provided automatic broom stick finishing machine from the Industrial Development Board to three internally displaced families who are engaging in small business of making ekel brooms in order to improve their business.
- All beneficiaries were made aware on sound financial management, packaging of products and marketing for long term sustainability of their income generating activities.
