\*\*The Fund enables the OR to make cash grants only. Hence, while the OR is deeply conscious of the emotional impact on a family as a result of the death of every family member irrespective of age, it was decided to utilize the limited funds then available to provide relief on priority basis to the families that suffered financial loss as a result of the death of a family member who was or may have been contributing to the economy of the family unit at the time of death. The OR proceeded on the assumption that every victim over 18 years was in that category. The OR does not wish to subordinate or trivialize the suffering of those who lost younger family members but proceeded at the outset to initially provide relief for financial loss. On subsequently receiving more monies to the Fund, families of those below 18 years were also given a grant.
